SEC. 6-3-1 CIGARETTE LICENSE.

- (a) **License Required.** No person, firm or corporation shall, in any manner, directly or indirectly, upon any premises, or by any device, sell, exchange, barter, dispose of or give away, or keep for sale, any cigarette, cigarette paper or cigarette wrappers, or any substitute therefor, without first obtaining a license as hereinafter provided.
- (b) **Application for License; Fee.** Every person, firm or corporation desiring a license under this Section shall file with the City Clerk-Treasurer a written application therefor, stating the name of the person and the place for which such license is desired. Each license shall be filed by the City Clerk-Treasurer and shall name the licensee and the place wherein he is authorized to conduct such business, and the same shall not be delivered until the applicant shall pay to the City Clerk-Treasurer a license fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00).
- (c) **Issuance and Term of License.** Licenses for the sale, exchange, barter, disposition of, or giving away or keeping for sale of cigarette paper or cigarette wrappers or any substitute therefor shall be issued by the City Clerk-Treasurer. Each license shall be issued on the first day of July each year, or thereafter whenever applied for, and shall continue in force from date of issuance until the succeeding June 30th unless sooner revoked for any violation of this Section.

SEC. 6-3-2 WITHHOLDING LICENSES.

- (a) **Municipal Debts.** Any license granted under this ordinance shall be withheld if the applicant owes delinquent or unpaid taxes, assessments, water or sewer charges or other claims to the City of Thorp.

- (b) **Municipal Forfeitures.** Any license granted under this ordinance shall be withheld if the applicant has failed to pay overdue municipal forfeitures.
