CITY OF THORP REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
MONDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2017 AT 6:30PM  
IN THORP CITY HALL

10. Consideration of parking restriction on Old School Ct. per Section 9-3-1(b)(1) of the City of Thorp Code of Ordinances  
M/M/S (Abramczak, Rosemeyer) to establish a no parking zone on the east side of Old School Ct. from the intersection with W. Stanley St. northward to the first existing driveway. Carried unanimously.
