

MINUTES
CITY OF THORP SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
WEDNESDAY, MAY 23, 2018 AT 6:00PM
IN THORP CITY HALL

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm. In attendance were Mayor Stroinski; Alderpersons Lawcewicz, Abramczak, and Wnek; and City Administrator Reeg. Alderpersons Maslowski and Rosemeyer were absent.

2. Comments and suggestions from citizens

None.

3. Public Hearing on proposed application for CDBG-PF funds including:

a. Open Public Hearing

Mayor Stroinski opened the public hearing.

b. Identification of total potential funds

Reeg, along with Jeff Nussbaum and Nate Day of SEH, discussed the project—noting a \$750,000 projected price tag with a potential 50% contribution of \$375,000 from the CDBG-PF program.

c. Eligible CDBG activities

Nate Day discussed the types of activities eligible to be funded with CDBG and CDBG-PF funds.

d. Presentation of identified community development needs

Reeg noted that the Well #9 treatment project was that being submitted for funding.

e. Identification of any community development needs by the public

None.

f. Presentation of activities proposed for CDBG application, including potential residential displacement

The proposed project scope was discussed with no residential or commercial displacement being anticipated.

g. Citizen input regarding proposed and other CDBG activities

None.

h. Close public hearing

M/M/S (Wnek, Lawcewicz) to close the public hearing. Carried unanimously.

4. Discussion and possible action relating to 2019-2023 5-Year Capital Plan

M/M/S (Wnek, Abramczak) to approve the 2019-2023 5-Year Capital Plan. Carried unanimously.

5. Discussion and possible action relating to creation of Community Resource Officer position within the Thorp Police Department

Reeg presented financial implication data, noting that for every \$5000 increase in the levy, a property with a \$100,000 assessment would see a ~\$7 increase in property taxes.

It was agreed by general consensus to begin formal discussion with the school district and union regarding the position.
