

MINUTES  
CITY OF THORP SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
WEDNESDAY, JULY 18, 2018 AT 5:15PM

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order. In attendance were Mayor Stroinski; Alderpersons Maslowski, Lawcewicz, Rosemeyer, and Wnek; and City Administrator Reeg.

2. Comments and suggestions from citizens

None.

3. Discussion and possible action relating to ice pigging proposals

Suez would be in the area in early August, and had provided a proposal for \$15,000 for 5350 feet of water main. It was agreed by general consensus that this timeline didn't work well with our pending well upgrade project and future unilateral flushing program. This service should be saved for a final mitigation effort after other enhancements were complete. It was agreed by general consensus to postpone this project until 2019 at some time.

4. Consider moving into closed session per Wis. Stats. 19.85(1)(e) to discuss the following:

a. Potential purchase of a city-owned parcel of land

M/M/S (Lawcewicz, Maslowski) to move into closed session. Carried unanimously.

5. Reconvene into open session for any action required as the result of closed session

M/M/S (Maslowski, Lawcewicz) to reconvene into open session. Carried unanimously.

M/M/S (Rosemeyer, Maslowski) authorizing the Mayor and City Administrator to convey the real estate parcel for the minimum price established in closed session (for negotiating purposes). Carried unanimously.

M/M/S (Lawcewicz, Maslowski) to adjourn at 5:42pm. Carried unanimously.
